*Speaker will be present and ready to deliver speech within 30 minute prep time.

*Topic slip must be given to judge prior to speech delivery.

*Speaker may NOT use any notes or note card during speech presentation.

*Movement is optional.

*Internet access is allowed in speech prep to access research stored online and actively research during preparation. Internet access is not guaranteed.

*The time limit is 7 minutes with a 30 second "grace period. Should a student go beyond the grace period, the student may not be ranked 1st.

No minimum time is mandated.
